It's a great day to get rid of old fencing, concrete, building materials, and items that didn't sell at your last garage sale. Do your trimming and teardowns before the 14th because the dumpsters fill up fast and are gone by noon. Again this year we have seven dumpsters for your convenience so bring it on!

## eWaste

Working and non-working electronics you want to get rid of are welcome. This year we have a single large eWaste dumpster hosted by the Lutz's at 1118 N. Freeman. So if it has a cord, bring it for recycling. This includes computers, old video games, printers, fax machines, rechargeable batteries, TV's, radios, CD players, DVD players & small household appliances.

## The Deal:

Each friendly volunteer Dumpster Monitor is responsible for verifying your residence in Washington Square (so bring ID), packing the dumpsters (heavy stuff at bottom), and monitoring contents of the waste.

**NOT** allowed in dumpsters are the following items: used oil, tires, paint, chemicals, medical waste or hazardous waste. You can take those items to Anaheim Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center 1071 N. Blue Gum St. Anaheim, 92806 Tuesday - Saturday 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.
